

DEVELOPING CLASSROOM SKILLS: THE EFFECTIVE FACILITATOR (3 WEEKS)

INTRODUCTION

This course is designed to provide participants with an overview of three specific areas of classroom skills: facilitation, delivery modes and cooperative learning skills.
